This is a copy of the Hughes Family Tree as I know it. It is really Cherrington-Prose-Hughes down to the V generation and then it splinters off into many different names. Down through the V generation, I am just copying off from there down. I am taking information from those who I can get it and the rest from memory. I have several different sources of information and sometimes there is a slight variation between the bits of information but I will try to put the second choice in names or dates in parenthesis. I got so very much verification from a book written by Dean C. Cherrington. I would like to give thanks to all the relatives who sent me helpful information but I'm afraid I might leave someone out so I will say thanks to everyone and please help me fill in the blank spaces.

1. Clement Cherrington, born in England in 1702 (or 1711), educated for a Priest in the Church of England, but sailed for America on the day set for his trial sermon in 1750. First married in England to Mary Jones. Probably had three children: John, Mary And Thomas. First settled on Long Island NY where he was married to Mary-Coles Mathews (a widow) born 1713 d. 1785. Issues 3 Children Thomas, Rachel, William. They then went to Pennsylvania.

11.3. William Cherrington, 3rd son of above union. Born in Berks County, Pa. Apr 19, 1779 died Apr 28, 1835. Went to Virginia in 1775, Married to Margaret hanks, (Aunt to Margaret hanks (Mother to Abraham Lincoln) Feb 18, 1779. About 1805 settled on Chickamauga Creek near Gallipolis, Ohio. Margaret hanks died Sep 22, 1797. Issue: 8 Children 2nd Marriage to widow Letitia McClung, Nov 28, 1797; born: Sep 11, 1765, died Sep 12, 1849. Progenitor of the Ohio branch of the family. Issue 8 children.

THE PASSING OF A REAL PIONEER IN DEATH OF THE LATE LEWIS M. HUGHES

The following splendid article was published in the Pioneer by Mrs. Cletie Norn, and was written by H. H. Hughes of Columbus, Ohio, a nephew of the late Lewis M. Hughes, former well known Warren county citizen who passed away in Pine Village, December 27th:

The death of Louis Hughes at Pine Village, Indiana, near Oxford, marks the passing of one of the last pioneers of the real out-of-doors.

It is very doubtful if there is a white man left who could go out alone—without a dog—and trail a fox for two or three days and come home with the fox.

Very few white men are left who can wade out in rocky streams, in water three or four feet deep, and catch bass in their bare hands.

Many people can verify the fact that Louis Hughes did these seemingly impossible things over and over again with as little thought that he was doing anything more unusual than to eat a good meal.

Few men living today know the intimate habits of animals and nature as this old pioneer did.

Louis Hughes was born in the hills of southern Ohio and was just too young to go to the Civil War with his three older brothers.

The fact that he liked his gun better than books, and the woods better than the school room did not mean that his mind was not busy.

As a boy, he became a real marksman with the old musket, and a successful hunter. His chief duty on the farm was to keep the squirrels out of the corn with the musket.

Fifty years ago, he established his home on a farm near Pine Village. The woods, game and clear streams, no doubt, had more to do with his selection of the location than the soil for farming.

Although a good farmer and orchard man of the old school, his real interest in all seasons was nature.

During the last fifteen years, he became well known through the Jackson Hole district of Wyoming as the best big game hunter in that section of the Rockies. He was particularly successful in trailing the elk. Although he was over seventy years old, he was in demand as a guide and always supplied the game.

The knowledge of nature and the habits of game, making it possible to trail down a fox by outwitting the fox, is something that most of us could not understand.

Few hunters of today could go out alone and follow a trail and ever see a fox, although the fox might see them many times.

To know his habits, to know how far he will travel without stopping to know the different habits on the trail of a male or female fox, to tell by the circles they make what they are looking for, then to be able by the lay of the land to locate the spot a mile away that the fox will probably select as his lookout, then to circle for miles so the fox will never get your scent in the breezes, then to locate the fox when perhaps only the tip of his head is visible and pick him off with a long range rifle—that's hunting, that we do not know how to appreciate.

Most of the neighbors, relatives and friends have just taken old Uncle Hughes for granted as old-fashioned, with his long beard that he has worn for half a century, and his success in hunting as marks of the old days, but few of us who really knew him and have witnessed his unusual skill have mingled with sportsmen, scouts, Indians, and guides of today enough to realize that many of the achievements of this old pioneer are so unusual that they will not be believed by the nature students of today.

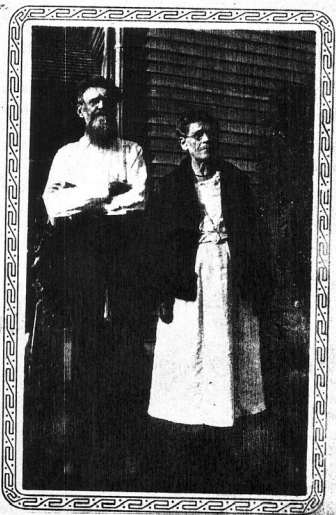
There are a few men who have learned to catch fish with their hands,

but Louis Hughes' method of catching fish most anywhere would be laughed off as just one more "fish story."

Students and historians of today are coming more and more to appreciate the knowledge, skill and hardy qualities of our early pioneers and their part in the building of America.

Modern scouting, sportsman and outdoor clubs and societies are trying in an organized way to pass on some of these values of knowing nature to the youth of this generation.

The more we understand the building of America and the problems of today, the more those who knew Louis Hughes will appreciate the opportunity to have known a real pioneer who carried on the spirit of the early days to this generation.
